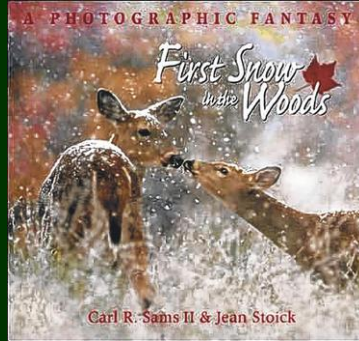

**Directions:** Northern Boulevard (25-A) to Berry Hill Road, heading North into Oyster Bay. When Berry Hill bears to the left, continue straight on Sandy Hill Road. Tiffany Creek Preserve entrance will be on left. If coming from Cove Road in Oyster Bay, turn onto Sandy Hill Road and take towards Berry Hill Road and Syosset. Before you get to where Sandy Hill runs into Berry Hill, Tiffany Creek entrance will be on right. Follow preserve road into parking lot where we will meet.
