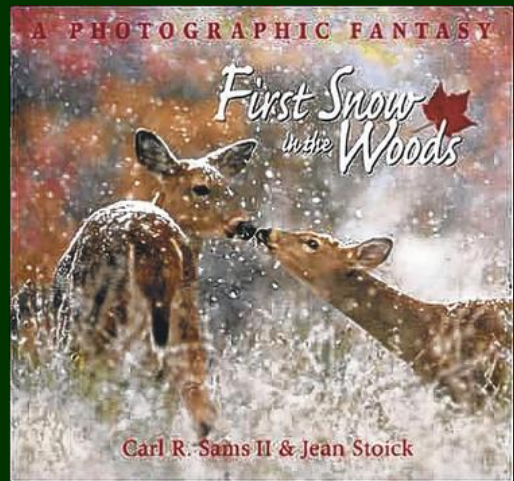


Holiday Gifts for the Birds
