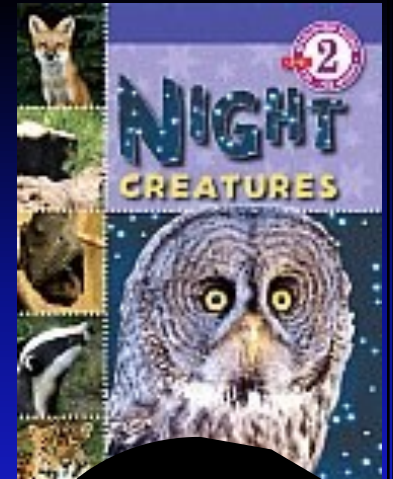


Huntington-Oyster Bay Audubon Presents

Directions: Long Island Expressway to Exit 41 North or Northern State Parkway to Exit 35 North. Proceed north on Route 106 towards Oyster Bay. Make left onto Northern Boulevard/Route 25A (west). By the police booth, make a right onto Wolver Hollow Road. Take to Chicken Valley Road, make a right. Continue on to Oyster Bay Road. At Bayville Road (Barney's restaurant is on corner) make a right. Please be prompt, program starts at 7:30 sharp!
