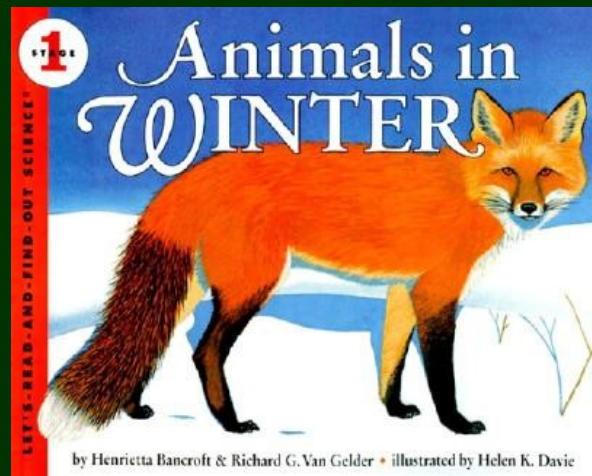


Huntington-Oyster Bay Audubon

With winter here, our feathered friends could use some extra food to help them survive the cold weather. Join Huntington-Oyster Bay Audubon as we learn how to give them a boost! We will start by reading *Animals in Winter*, by *Henrietta Bancroft*, a story of how our wild neighbors prepare for the winter's cold; then turn crafty and use pine cones, suet, dried fruits, and birdseed to make bird feeders. We'll hang them for the birds, and then take a winter's ramble in the woods!

For kids of all ages and easy enough for young children to enjoy. **Note that most birdseed is processed in plants that also process peanuts if allergies are an issue.** Please dress according to the weather.
