Recent Discoveries about Bird Song

Dr. David Lahti, professor from Queens College, will share the latest revelations about bird songs, thanks to our modest house finch. The house finch (Haemorhous mexicanus) is a common New York bird that was introduced here from California in the 1940s. In the last decade his laboratory has contributed to this bird's research prominence with studies of house finch song in New York, California, and Hawaii. This research has resulted in various interesting discoveries that will be discussed in this lecture.

Speaker Bio: Dr. Lahti is an Associate Professsor and Director of the Master's Program in Biology, Queens College, and Doctoral Faculty in Biology and Psychology, The Graduate Center, City University of New York.
